What is the Remain at Home Rent Assistance Program?

Our Remain at Home Rent Assistance program is dedicated to keeping **at-risk families** in their hard-earned homes by providing critical financial support during times of hardship. A donation of just **\$1,500** goes directly into our rent assistance fund, offering immediate relief to families facing eviction and helping them stay safely housed. Your support ensures stability, dignity, and a brighter future for those who need it most.

What Is the Overall Goal of the Remain at Home Rent Assistance Program?

Our overall Remain at Home Rent Assistance Program goal is to secure **100** individuals, families, organizations, or groups to help 100 Interfaith families avoid homelessness by receiving the support and skills needed to overcome their crisis and achieve self-sufficiency.

The Need for Community Support

Every year, Interfaith invests \$1.5 million to provide critical support for homeless and at-risk families, without relying on government funding. Your sponsorship directly empowers this mission, helping families maintain permanent housing, secure stable employment with livable wages, and obtain the life skills they need to thrive. The impact goes beyond individual families. By breaking the cycle of homelessness, Interfaith's work saves Dallas taxpayers nearly \$8 million annually by keeping families out of subsidized housing. Martinez Family Story



In the Spring of 2025, the Martinez family enrolled in Interfaith Family Services' non-residential program, seeking rental assistance. Interfaith was able to provide the family with \$800 in rental assistance and \$300 toward utility costs, giving them much-needed financial relief and stability. As part of the program, Mr. Martinez enrolled in Interfaith's GED program to expand his career opportunities and increase his earning potential with the City of Dallas, where he is employed.

To support his success, Interfaith provided a scholarship for a laptop, training resources, and study materials. Mrs. Martinez also made incredible progress during their time in the program. With guidance and encouragement from her Career Coach, she was able to secure employment, helping to further strengthen the family's financial foundation. The Martinez' story reflects the power of resilience, determination, and support.
